In the past **5 years**, the **Delta Dental Foundation** has invested more than **\$4 million** in **Ohio**.

Pandemic Relief Funding

 \$600,000 in COVID-19 emergency relief to 135 safety-net dental clinics, food banks, homeless shelters, dental schools and other nonprofits in Michigan, Ohio and Indiana.

Dental Schools

The DDF provides support to dental schools throughout the state of Ohio to better educate the next generation of dental professionals.

- The Ohio State University College of Dentistry to fund the Delta Dental Foundation Ambulatory Surgery Center
- Case Western Reserve University School of Dental medicine to fund a dental clinic at the new health campus
- Scholarships and awards, including the
 Community Commitment Award, to support
 dental students who commit to practice in a
 designated health professional shortage area
 for at least one year after graduation



Health Equity

The DDF supports programs and institutions working to improve health equity in oral and overall health for underserved populations.

- **Medworks Dental Care** to support free dental care at an annual event held in Cleveland
- The Ohio Department of Health for the Fluoridation Assistance Program
- Project Accessible Oral Health for an app that supports oral health care for individuals with autism



Better Outcomes, Brighter Futures

The Delta Dental Foundation (DDF) is a nonprofit, charitable organization established in 1980, which serves as the philanthropic arm of Delta Dental of Michigan, Ohio, Indiana, and North Carolina. DDF is dedicated to developing and enhancing partnerships and programs to improve health equity in oral and overall health.

Education

The DDF supports organizations that provide educational programming on the importance of oral health and how it relates to overall health.

- Brush, oral health curriculum and training for WIC and Headstart staff and students
- Cincinnati Children's Museum to support an oral health exhibit and field trips
- The Smile Squad Patch Program offered to Girl Scouts in participating councils in Ohio
- Reach Out and Read Ohio and the Ohio Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics' Brush, Book, Bed to support children's literacy
- The Rethink Your Drink: Water's Cool at School to install water filtration stations and encourage healthy choices at more than 45 schools statewide
- "I Need My Teeth" oral health education assembly for elementary students

Dental Clinics and Equipment

The DDF provides support to safety-net dental clinics to purchase necessary dental equipment to expand care for underserved populations.

- Children's Hospital Medical Center of Akron for specialty equipment to treat complex pediatric patients
- Faith Mission in Worthington to serve people experiencing homelessness
- Greene County Health District to expand care for vulnerable populations
- McMicken Integrated Care Clinic in Cincinnati to equip a dental clinic for people experiencing homelessness
- Rocking Horse Community Health Center in Springfield to equip a treatment room devoted to patients with special needs

School-based Health

The DDF supports school-based health initiatives to make dental care more accessible and increase the number of children who are seen and receive dental treatment. Examples include:

- Aiken High School-Based Dental Clinic in Cincinnati
- Cleveland Clinic to support their school-based health care program
- Delta Dental Center at Oyler School in Cincinnati
- Edgewood School-Based Health Center in Trenton
- Fairfield School-Based Health Center in Fairfield
- Valley View Health Center in Akron
- West Clermont School-Based Dental Center in Batavia
- Academy of World Languages Integrated Health Hub in Evanston
